



### Reviewer Instructions

InGenio follows a double blind review process. Once completed the evaluation form, it will be passed to the (corresponding) author of the manuscript. S/he will know the form with the comments, but s/he will not know the names of the reviewers. These data will remain in custody of the editorial team. However, InGenio understands that reviewers accept, unless explicitly stated otherwise, the inclusion of their names in an acknowledgment list as it considers appropriate.

In general, InGenio requires to reviewers to fulfil a form that contains the following aspects:

- Title
- Characterization of the manuscript
- Overall Evaluation
- Final Recommendation
- Confidential Comments to the Editors
- Comments to the Author

The overall criteria that reviewers must evaluate in manuscripts are focused on the following five points:

- Originality/Scientific Method
- Completeness of the Reported Work
- Contribution to the Field
- Clarity of Presentation and quality of tables and figures
- Reference to the Work of Others

Reviewers should remember that authors will be grateful for positive feedback that could allow them to improve their work.
